Dear Parents, Caregivers and Whanau,

I hope you are all keeping warm as we feel the effects of winter hitting us this week.

The next few school days at Te Anau School are really important to us in terms of our parent engagement and whanau relationships. Tomorrow, our mid year reports will go home and our mid year interviews will take place on Monday and Tuesday after school next week.

We will send home our school reports via HERO tomorrow. This is the first time that we have sent reports home this way so although we hope that it is super smooth and easy, we know there might also be some hiccups as there are with any new system.

Tomorrow morning around 11am you will receive a notification from HERO that you have some new posts. There will be one for each area of Reading, Writing and Maths. You will also be able to see more information about your child under the 'report' section of your app. This includes data about where your child is achieving academically against expectations. Your child's attendance data will also be visible.

The second part of this process is our Parent Teacher Interviews that will take place on Monday and Tuesday of next week. These interviews are a great opportunity to touch base with your child's teacher, discuss their report and look at the next steps in their learning journey.

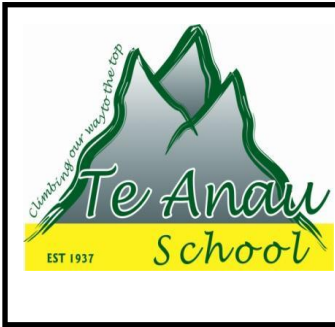

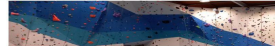
