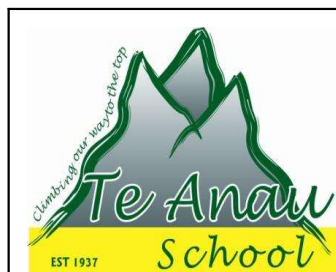

## HOMESTAY FAMILIES

Fiordland College has enjoyed welcoming International Students from many different countries for over 25 years and takes pride in the unique Fiordland experience that the College and the wider community offers. With the re-opening of our borders, International Student applications are once again coming in.

We have a 16 year old male student from Germany who would like to study at Fiordland College in Terms 1-2 next year. We are seeking expressions of interest from families who would like to be Henrik's homestay family. Henrik is an active teen who enjoys many sports including hockey, basketball and weight training. Henrik loves the outdoors and would like to have a homestay 'brother' of a similar age, although this is not a requirement.

Homestay families need to provide meals and snacks, a bedroom (which could be shared) and care for the student as they would for their own child. You would receive \$260 per week for this.

Previous homestay families have found the experience worthwhile and enjoyable, with the whole family benefiting from having someone from a different culture in their homes.
