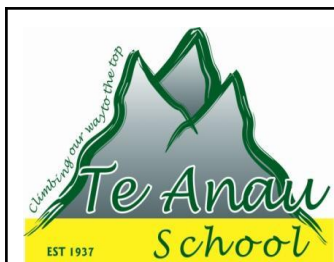
Next Meeting - The next organising meeting will be held on **Thursday 1st June, 7pm** at school. It would be great to get more parents along to ensure the event's success.
