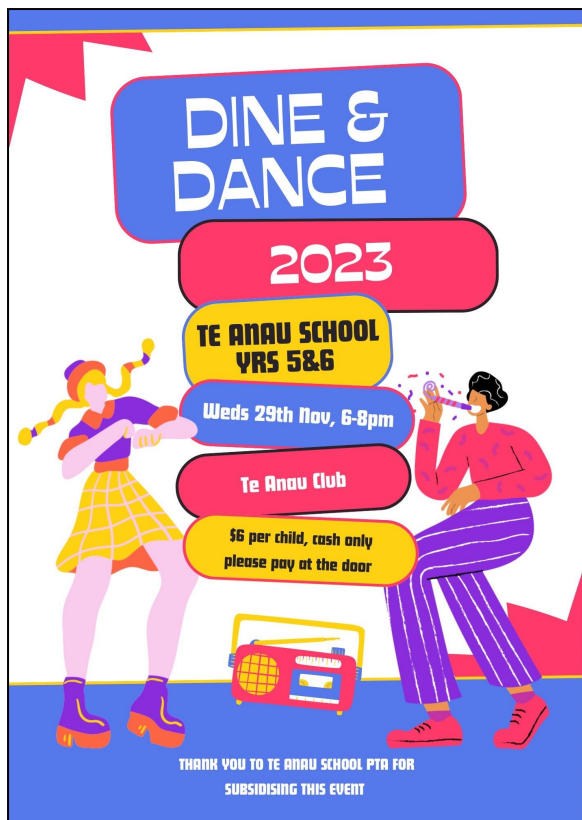
### Poppet Clothing Uniform Visit

## Having Hero App Problems?

Are you having Hero App problems? Try using another device or remove the app off and reload using the steps below.

Please follow the following steps to sign up to Hero:

1. Go to the App Store or Play Store and download the Hero app or go to [our.linc-ed.com](http://our.linc-ed.com)
2. Select "New User". Your account will be set up by your school using the email address that you provided when you enrolled your children, use this address to request a password.
3. Add your email address - Select the "Request Password Link."
4. Check your email - Hero will send you an email with a link to follow.
5. Follow the link - This will take you to a secure page to enter your chosen password.
6. Once this is done you should come to a page with basic information on your child.
