The children first learnt what to do in an earthquake and then had a go inside the trailer. There are some examples of writing from our Room 13 tamariki later in this newsletter.

The children were taught two sayings, 'Drop, Cover, Hold' in the case of an earthquake and 'Long or Strong, Get Gone' for if they are near the ocean.

This was a great follow-up from our earthquake drill at the beginning of the term. We have some very prepared learners at Te Anau School.
