

Kia ora Whānau,

It was great to see everyone in and around the school on Monday and Tuesday for our beginning of the year parent teacher interviews. I know the teachers enjoyed meeting everyone properly as the year began.

Next Friday our Senior Team has their Athletics Day here at school. This is a great day for all students to try their best in the traditional athletics disciplines.

Athletics isn't necessarily everyone's favourite day. It is important that we recognise that success on the day is different for everyone. 

We are an enthusiastic group of people who love their Triumph Classic cars.


We have just hosted the annual TR Conference in Alexandra with people from North Cape to Bluff and some even from Australia attending.
