Dear Parents, Caregivers and Whanau,

It has been great to have a couple of fine days in a row. The children have been out and about around the school enjoying the warmth.

Under Level 2 of COVID-19 all of our children have been very good at following hygiene systems. It is simply the 'new normal'. Thank you to all the parents who have been taking the time to sign in when they have entered the school site. This is a really important part of our contact tracing systems.

During lockdown a lot of new learning went on in regards to distance learning and using technology. This learning was for both the teachers and the children. This learning has led well into our new topic that our classes will start over the next week. This topic is based on our new Digital Technologies curriculum.

Through this topic the children will focus on two areas:

Computational thinking for digital technologies

– They'll learn core programming concepts so that they can become creators of digital technology, not just users.

Designing and developing digital outcomes

– Students will learn how to design quality, fit-for-purpose digital solutions that people can use.

Again there will be a lot of new learning for both teachers and students throughout this unit. During Thursday and Friday this week teachers are working with Lara Kirk from a company called Using Technology Better. This is to help them refine their skills before launching into the new topic.

It will be exciting to see what our students create.
