Dear Parents, Caregivers and Whanau,

We had some great news last week. We heard from the Meridian Energy Power Up Community Fund to tell us that our hall project has been given \$20,000 from the fund. This raised our total to \$208,154! Mr Anderson and I also sold sausages outside the hall during voting on Saturday. This means our total is now \$208,349! We are making steady progress upwards and once we have held our Horse Racing evening on November 7, I'll give you another update of our funds.

The Meridian Energy Power Up Community Fund have been long term supporters of our school. They have helped fund digital devices, our school pool cover and now our hall to name a few. I know the whole school community is thankful for their support.

On another note, last week we finalised our appointments for teachers for our 2021 year. We made two appointments. 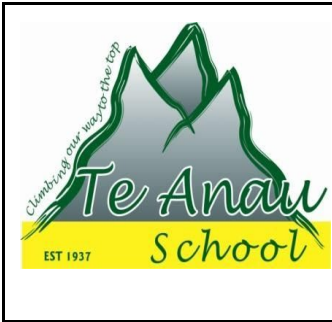
