### Poppet Clothing

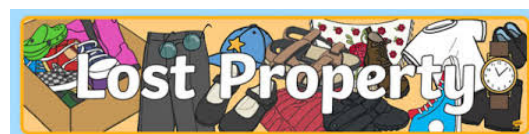
